1. In accordance with authority contained in reference (a) on 30 April, 1945, Technical Sergeant John P. BIBEALULT (272927) USMC will take charge of the enlisted men named in enclosure (D) and proceed via rail as routed by the Base Disbursing and Transportation Officer to New ~~York City~~, New York. Men concerned are authorized a furlough including travel time to expire at 0800 on the date opposite the name of each man. Days in excess of thirty (30) will be considered travel time and will not be charged as furlough. Upon expiration of furlough men will report to the Commanding General or the Commanding Officer of the Post or Station to which assigned, for duty.

2. Technical Sergeant BIBEALULT is responsible for the safety and conduct of the men under his charge while enroute and just prior to arrival at the destination he will instruct each member of the detail as to the effective date of expiration of furlough. Enclosure (B) will be completed and mailed at New York City, New York.

3. In case of accident or serious illness while on furlough, necessitating medical treatment, the man concerned will notify the Commanding Officer of his new station and request that he be advised of the nearest Naval Activity where treatment may be obtained.

4. Personnel returning to the United States from malarial areas will take their regular doses (not to exceed 1 tablet per day) of atabrine until they have reported at their new station.

5. In the event of death or extremely serious illness of members of the immediate family, necessitating an extension of furlough, the man concerned will request the extension of furlough from the Commandant of the Marine Corps, Washington, D.C. furnishing the following information:

(a) Name, rank, serial number, and new station to which assigned.
(b) Date of commencement and termination of present furlough.
(c) Whether furlough is Emergency or Regular.

(d) Furlough address. (Report any change of address while on furlough to the Commanding Officer of the new station.)

(e) Full reason for requesting extension.

Requests for extension of this furlough can be granted only by the Commandant of the Marine Corps. Non-receipt of reply to requests for extension is not an excuse for failure to report on the date prescribed in basic orders.

6. Administrative Details:

(a) Rations in kind were furnished to and including breakfast, 30 April, 1945.

(b) Staff Returns (including service record book, health record, and 940 card) will be forwarded by registered mail from this Center.

(c) Personnel listed herein have not been taken up on the rolls of this Center. They will be joined by the new station as joining from the station last shown in their service record books

(d) A countersigned copy of this order constitutes furlough papers and travel orders.

7. The Base Disbursing and Transportation Officer will furnish subsistence and rail transportation to New York City, New York. T/R M-942111 for 59 intermediate class tickets, San Diego to New York City, New York and T/R M-942112 for 30 upper tourists and 29 lower tourists berths San Diego to New York City, New York and 11 meal tickets numbers 626418 to 626428 inclusive each for 59 meals. In individual cases where the cost of transportation (rail and pullman) to the government from San Diego, California to the destination of troop train is in excess of the cost of transportation to the government from San Diego to new station via shortest usually traveled route, the transportation issuing officer will collect the difference at the time of issuing transportation. Subsistence will be issued on the basis of the shortest usually traveled route between San Diego, California to the new station. In individual cases where the cost of transportation and subsistence to the government from San Diego, California to destination of troop train is less than the cost of transportation and subsistence to the government from San Diego, California to new station via the shortest usually traveled route, the individual concerned may submit claim to the disbursing officer of the quartermaster department for reimbursement. Men are not authorized to sign emergency meal tickets.

8. Personnel are not authorized to participate in press conferences, talk to reporters, or talk over the radio except after consultation with and clearance of the subject by a Public Relations Officer of the Navy or the Marine Corps.
